



UWA Undergraduate Scholarship (Mauritius)



About the scholarship

UWA's undergraduate fee discount scholarships will be awarded to eligible students from Mauritius, who have demonstrated high academic achievement in their high school studies and who have been accepted to undertake a Bachelor's degree at UWA, commencing in 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Award details

Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank	Annual Scholarship
Equivalent ATAR of 85 - 89.99	\$3,000 AUD
Equivalent ATAR of 90 or more	\$7,000 AUD

How to apply

Applicants to UWA are automatically considered and do not need to submit an additional application for this scholarship.

The scholarship offer must normally be accepted within 14 days from the date of the offer being made, after which time the University may revoke the scholarship offer.



Eligibility

The Scholarship would be awarded to students who meet the criteria below:

- Be a citizen of Mauritius;
- Have achieved an equivalent ATAR¹ of at least 85 in previous studies used for entry to UWA;
- Be enrolled, or eligible to enrol, full-time in an undergraduate degree course;
- Laureate student, any students ranked in the top 200 or above nationally on their overall performance, or that have completed high school studies at one of the schools in the list of eligible schools.

¹An equivalent ATAR is determined by UWA Admissions from previous studies used for entry into the University.

Conditions

Duration: The Scholarship applies for the total duration of studies at UWA in the applicable course (as stated in the student's offer letter).

Load: The reduced fee only applies if students maintain a 100% load (normally 48 points), and will not be extended if a student does not complete within the total course duration stated on their offer letters.

Method of payment

The scholarship is

- Provided as a fee reduction towards the recipient's eligible course fees; and
- Applied to the recipient's course fees in two equal instalments each year, one each semester

Criteria for continuation

The recipient must:

- Continue to meet the eligibility requirements
- Remain enrolled full-time
- Make satisfactory progress in accordance with the rules for the course for which the scholarship is awarded, and
- Confirm twice annually, in the manner and by the dates specified by the University, that they continue to meet the eligibility requirements of the scholarship.
